

**PROPOSED JOINT VENTURE INVOLVING HUTCHISON PORTS SOKHNA LIMITED, CMA TERMINALS SAS, AND GOLDEN CHANCE INVESTMENT ENTERPRISE LIMITED.**

Following a notification from COMESA Competition Commission, the Fair-Trading Commission (hereinafter referred to as “the Commission”) is currently analyzing the proposed joint venture involving HUTCHISON PORTS SOKHNA LIMITED, CMA TERMINALS SAS, and GOLDEN CHANCE INVESTMENT ENTERPRISE LIMITED.

HUTCHISON PORTS SOKHNA LIMITED, CMA TERMINALS is an indirect subsidiary of Hutchison Port Holdings Limited. It is also a member of Hutchison Ports Group (HPG) which is a global developer and operator of container terminal and provider of associated logistical services. GOLDEN CHANCE INVESTMENT ENTERPRISE LIMITED is a leading port operator engaged in cargo shipping, logistics, ship building and repairing, ship management services, marine engineering, terminal operations and related financial and IT Services.

Seychelles is listed among the Member States that will be affected or is likely to be affected by the proposed transaction. The Commission is informed that CMA group operates in Seychelles through **Societe Seychelloise de Navigation Ltd.** The Commission’s primary concern is to determine whether or not the transaction is likely to substantially lessen or prevent competition in the Common Market or to be contrary to the public interest.
